HIV prevention and services

Your plan provides support to help keep you and your loved ones healthy, including:

- HIV screenings
- PrEP medications, as well as necessary clinic visits and lab tests*
- PEP medicine
- HIV treatment*

Behavioral health support

Our network of behavioral health clinicians offers confidential support to help with challenges you may be dealing with, such as:

- · Stress, anxiety and depression
- · Bipolar and related disorders
- Trauma and post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD)
- · Family and couples therapy
- · Grief, loss and more

Sometimes, finding a therapist you feel safe and comfortable with can make all the difference. At **myuhc.com**, you can search for behavioral and mental health providers who list themselves as LGBTQ+ supporters. Tap the Find Care & Costs tab and type LGBTQ+ in the search bar. You'll be guided to caring providers who are here to help.

Important things to know



Pre-certification or prior authorization is required for gender-affirming surgical treatment. Coverage for certain services may vary. Reference your Summary Plan Description (SPD) located by selecting the plan information quick link at **yourbenefitsresources.com/deere** or connect with an Advocate for more information.



You may file a claim appeal within 180 days if you or your physician disagrees with a pre-certification or prior authorization decision, or your claim is denied. Reference your medical plan documents for more information. Advocates are available to help you file an appeal.

Gender-affirming care

Here is a partial list of gender-affirming procedures covered by your health care benefits:

- Breast surgery**
- Genital surgery**
- Hormone therapy**
- Hair removal required for reconstructive surgery**
- Hysterectomy (removal of uterus)**
- Tracheal shave**
- Voice modification therapy
- Voice modification surgery**

Family formation

A variety of family planning benefits are offered that may be covered by your employer. This includes the adoption and surrogacy reimbursement benefit. This benefit covers up to a lifetime maximum of \$30,000. Go to the reimbursement page of the benefit portal at **yourbenefitsresources.com/deere** for more information. For salary and management represented production employees, the fertility solutions program is available to support any fertility questions. A nurse can be reached at **1-866-774-4626**.

When an employer selects UnitedHealthcare standard benefits, fertility preservation is covered if an individual is undergoing gender-affirming surgery that will render them permanently infertile/sterile. This includes egg retrieval or sperm collection, cryopreservation and storage for 12 months. For additional information regarding family formation benefits, please contact a trained Advocate.
